H.E.A.R.S.

HEARS is an all-volunteer non-profit inside of a Pikes Peak Sertoma organization, specifically to provide hearing screenings and subsidized hearing aids to lower income clients.

Our mission is to improve the quality of life for those impacted by hearing loss. Local Sertoma clubs and HEARS perform many services and operate programs around hearing health, risks to hearing, and subsidizing hearing aids for those who cannot afford them.

HEARS Hearing Aid Program

HEARS provides professional audiology services and hearing aids to citizens of El Paso County who are below or near Federal poverty income levels. We assist an average of 75 people every year regain the gift of hearing.

Clients with incomes below 125% of Federal guidelines are fully subsidized by HEARS, receiving new digital hearing aids and all testing, fitting, and follow-up services through a local Audiologist.



To qualify, one must be a US citizen, a resident of El Paso County, and meet federal income requirements. HEARS receives zero federal or state funding.

All-volunteer, HEARS provides almost \$4 in value for every \$1 of donation - and 99% of all donations are spent providing services to our clients. HEARS 5K Fundraiser (www.H5KE.org)
