Thank You for your support in 2018 - It was a very good year for the hearing impaired in El Paso County:

- We raised over \$11,700 at the 2018 HEARS 5K, providing almost 25% of our annual budget.
- HEARS is all volunteer and every dollar of support provides almost \$4 in value our annual budget equates to almost \$250,000 of valuable support for those in our community who need extra help with their hearing.
- HEARS helps 70-75 lower income El Paso County residents every year get new hearing aids.
- The 2018 HEARS 5K had 27% more participants.

Our goal for 2019 is a 30 percent increase in funds raised by H5KE in 2018.
